Context :-

Cyber Law is important because it touches almost all aspects of transactions and activities concerning Cyberspace. Initially, it may seem that Cyber Law is a very technical field that does not have any bearing to most activities in Cyberspace. However, every action and every reaction in Cyberspace, whether we realize it or not, has some legal perspectives. In view of rapid increasing use of cyberspace, being ultimate medium ever evolved in human history, every activity in Cyberspace will have a Cyber legal perspective. There are various Cyber Law issues involved in registering the Domain Name, setting up of website, launching the website, sending and receiving e mails and in many other activities. In macro, one may not be aware regarding the background functionalities of the day to day cyber activities. Sooner or later, it may be realized how important it is to know the cyber laws involved in carrying out those activities. To combat all, Cyber law awareness workshop will play an important role as an eye opener for the individuals who are using Internet for various operations.

He was a member of the IT Act Policy Advisory Group of the Ministry of Information and Technology and the Inter Ministerial Working group on Cyber Security and Cyber Laws of the Ministry of Communication and Information Technology. He is also a Member of the e-Governance Advisory Group of the Government of Karnataka and has been providing his inputs to the policy formulation in the area of Cyber Laws and Cyber Security at the Central Government level. He is the founder secretary of Cyber Society of India.

Naavi is the author of the first book on Cyber Laws in India titled "Cyber Laws for Every Netizen in India" (1999) and first e-Book on Cyber Laws in India titled "Cyber Laws in India, ITA-2000 and Beyond". He has also authored a book titled "CyLawCom., Corporate Mantra for the Digital Era" and the first book on Cyber Crimes in a regional language in India.

Naavi has been also teaching Cyber Laws in Department of Criminology, Madras University, School of Excellence at Ambedkar Law College, and Nalsar Law University, Hyderabad as well as KLE Society's Law College Bangalore. He also conducts training programme for TN Police in Cyber Crimes.

Naavi's educational initiatives include the development of the CyLawCom certification programme for the industry and a unique Course for developing Techno-Legal Cyber Professionals for the first time in the country. He also provides consultancy to Companies on Techno-Legal Cyber Security programmes.
