

NIT DURGAPUR, MENTORING THE NEW NIT AT ARUNACHAL PRADESH

Government of India decided to set up 10 new NITs during the 11th Five Year Plan in the States/UTs which are not having NITs at present. Accordingly, Union Cabinet has approved 10 new NITs in various parts of the India. NIT, Arunachal Pradesh is one of those new NITs to be mentored by NIT, Durgapur. NIT Arunachal Pradesh shall be temporarily housed in **Yupia**, the district headquarters of the Papum Pare district of Arunachal Pradesh. Itanagar, the capital of Arunachal Pradesh is situated in the same district. An all weather road to the other parts of the country connects Yupia.

Yupia is around 18 kilometers from Itanagar and around 11 kilometers from Naharlagan, which is the twin capital town.

The nearest railway station is Harmutty (Meter Gauge), which is around 36 kilometers. A Broad Gauge railway line is being laid to connect it to other parts of the country.

The nearest airport is Lilabari, which is around 50 kilometres and nearest helipad is at Naharlagan. Daily helicopter services are available between Guwahati and Naharlagan except on Sundays.

Besides, day and night bus services are available from Guwahati, which is around 400 kilometers from Naharlagan.

The site of the NIT is situated on a flat land surrounded by beautiful and green forest and mountains. The area is picturesque and serene and has an ideal academic environment. In the vicinity of the Institute are the offices of the District Officials like the Deputy Commissioner, the District Medical Officer, the Deputy Director of School Education, the District Planning Officer etc.

Initially it is proposed to have three departments in the institution viz. **Electrical Engineering, Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering and Computer Science and Engineering with an intake of 30 each.**

Classes shall be conducted in fully furnished classrooms located in a beautiful building. Separate hostel facilities for boys and girls are available. The campus shall be having round the clock electricity and water supply facility. State of art internet and telecommunication facility are also being installed in the campus.

The climatic condition of Yupia

Annual Mean Rainfall	365 mm
Maximum Temperature	27.50°C
Minimum Temperature	13.50°C

In summers, it is sufficiently hot but in winters it will be cold. Winter extends from October to February.

The places of interest near Yupia are the Ganga Lake (Geekar Sinyi), the Itafort, and Jawaharlal Nehru Museum etc.
